TENDER FOR NURSERY ROAD WIDENING

This Contract is tendered for the widening of Nursery Road including a right turn lane to the new administration building.

The work will include earth excavation; construction of approximately 475 linear meters of 3:1 ditch; approximately 2,360m² of granular "B" and approximately 2,060m² of granular "A" for road base; approximately 1,330 m² of HL4 base asphalt and 1,530m² of HL3 surface asphalt; 26m of concrete curb; entrance culverts; restoration and pavement markings.

Complete tender documents will be available on Thursday, May 7, 2009, for the non-refundable sum of forty dollars (\$40.00), including GST payable to Ainley and Associates Ltd.
