Please join me and the SERVE Committee in the development of the Community Campus Partnership Strategy.

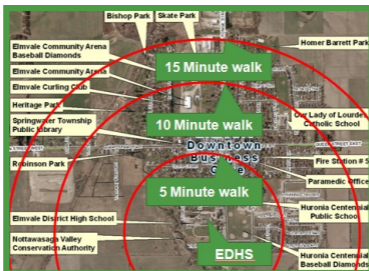
Education and public-private partnerships are key to the success for a sustainable education campus.
