Springwater Township Mayor Tony Guergis will be on hand with Deputy Mayor Tony Hope and Councillor Dan Clement, who will be acting as MC for the ribbon cutting taking place at 11:00 am.

There will be local entertainment, lots of asparagus, maple syrup, rhubarb and baking, as well as artisans and crafts. The Springwater Township Rotary Club will be at the community table to greet visitors, and provide free recipe cards and gardening gloves to visitors.

This year, the market will be held on Saturdays from 8:00 am until 1:00 pm in the parking lot at the Knox Building in Elmvale, (35 Queen St. W.). The Farmers' Market Committee is also working on a Program of Events which will showcase local talent and celebrate themes such as strawberry season and the fall harvest.

Springwater is a municipality of approximately 18,000 residents located in the heart of Simcoe County and consistently offers residents one of the lowest property tax rates, in comparison to similar sized municipalities in the area. Springwater Township is also home to the second largest concentration of County Forests and is a popular destination for outdoor activities in all four seasons.

In 2009, the Township celebrated its 15th anniversary of the amalgamated Township of Springwater.
