SPRINGWATER TOWNSHIP / May 10, 2010 – Residents will have a one stop shop for driver's licences and health cards in Elmvale, as the Driver and Vehicle office converts to a ServiceOntario office on May 10th, 2010.

Starting May 10th, the office will be offering services for health cards in addition to driver's licences. In the past, residents would have had to travel to downtown Barrie to renew their health cards.

Health card services now being offered for photo health cards include name and address changes, replacing lost or stolen cards and most renewals.

Issuer Paul Reid assures residents they will have the same people and the same services as before, but now they will have a different name, and more options.
