
Notice of Decision For Minor Variance/Permission

Application No.: A10/23

Owners/Applicants: T. and J. Cantelon

In the matter of an application to the Committee of Adjustment of Springwater Township under Section 45 of the Planning Act of Ontario, R.S.O. 1990. c.P. 13, as amended for lands legally described as Part of Lot 6, Concession 6, being Part 5 on Plan 51R-42586, former Township of Flos, now in the Township of Springwater (having no municipal address), being Roll No. 4341 030 006 01103.

That the decision of the Committee of Adjustment, having given consideration to the applicable provisions of Section 45 of the Planning Act, the Official Plan of the Township of Springwater, the characteristics of the land in question and its surroundings as addressed in the Planning Report on the application dated May 24, 2023, the correspondence received and information presented at the hearing held on May 24, 2023 and the discussion on the matter, hereby APPROVE Application A10/23 as applied for.

The purpose and effect of the application is to permit the construction of a new single detached dwelling with a reduced rear yard setback, as described below:

1. A rear yard depth of 10.39 metres (34.09 feet), whereas Section 13.3.4.b. requires a minimum of 15 metres (49.21 feet).

The last day to appeal this decision is June 13, 2023.

Additional information regarding the application is available for inspection in the Planning Department at the Township of Springwater Administration Centre, 2231 Nursery Road during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Appeal of a Decision

Notice of appeal must be filed with the Secretary-Treasurer for the Township of Springwater Committee of Adjustment, must set out the reasons for the appeal and must be accompanied by the fee required by the Ontario Land Tribunal.

Please note neighbours and other interested parties not defined by the Planning Act are no longer eligible to file appeals for this application as per Bill 23, More Homes Built Faster Act, 2022.

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, a "specified person" (as defined by Section 1(1) of the Planning Act), and any "public body" (as defined by Section 1(1) of the Planning Act) within 20 days of the making of the decision may appeal the decision by the Committee of Adjustment to the Ontario Land Tribunal. The secretary-treasurer of a committee, upon receipt of a notice of appeal filed under subsection (12), shall forthwith forward the notice of appeal and the amount of the fee mentioned in subsection (12) to the Tribunal by registered mail together with all papers and documents filed with the committee of adjustment relating to the matter appealed from and such other documents and papers as may be required by the Tribunal.

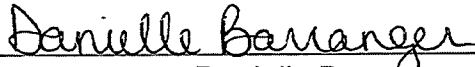
If within such 20 days no notice of appeal is given, the decision of the committee is final and binding, and the secretary-treasurer shall notify the applicant and shall file a certified copy of the decision with the clerk of the municipality.


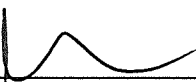

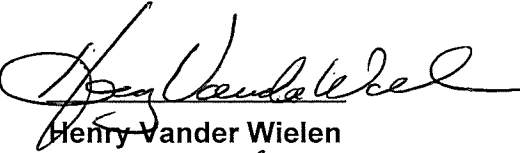
