You are eligible to vote in Springwater's election on October 26 if you:

- Are a Canadian citizen
- Are 18 years of age or older on election day
- Are a resident, owner, tenant or spouse of an owner or tenant of property in Springwater

Register through Elections Ontario by August 12 at **RegisterToVoteON.ca**. After this date, registration updates will be made through the Clerks department.

Dates and times of the Voting Locations will be noted on the Voter Information Letters which will be mailed to eligible electors in September.

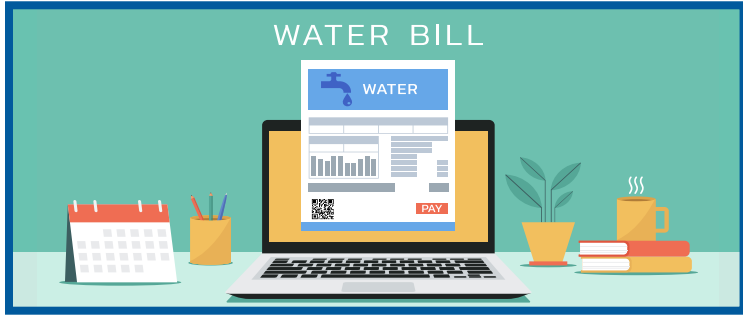

# Your Water Bill is on the Way!



The Township issues water and wastewater bills on a quarterly basis for residential accounts and monthly for multi-residential and commercial accounts.

**Late June:** Our third-party contractor, Wamco Waterworks, will be reading residential water meters.

**Late July:** Water and wastewater bills will be mailed to residents.

**End of August:** Payments for water and wastewater bills are due.

Please ensure your water and/or wastewater bill is paid by the due date.

A late payment charge of 1.25% per month will be added to overdue balances. Water service may be disconnected if an account remains unpaid.

If you do not receive a bill, you are still responsible for ensuring payment is made on time and for any applicable late payment charges.

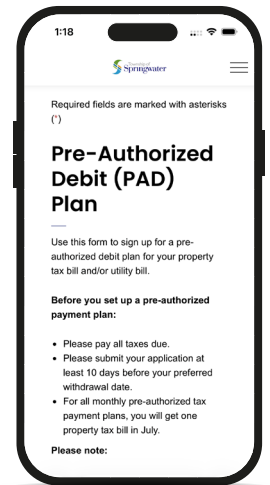

# Know Your Watering Days

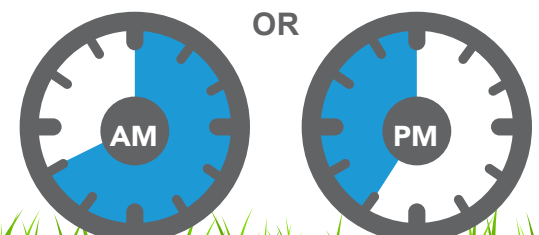
