

- Are a resident, owner, tenant or spouse of an owner or tenant of property in Springwater

Register through Elections Ontario by August 12 at RegisterToVoteON.ca. After this date, registration updates will be made through the Clerks department.

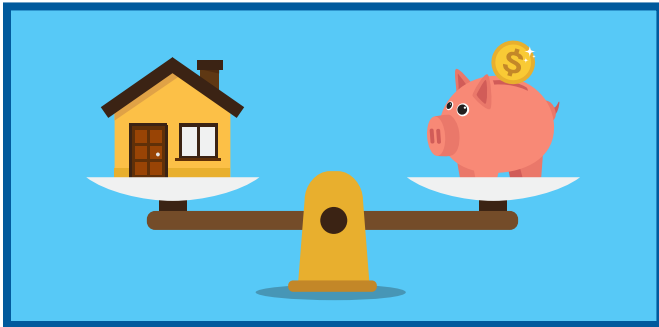

Be Prepared – Get an Emergency Kit!

Emergency preparedness is everyone's responsibility. Know the potential risks and hazards, and plan ahead.

An emergency kit should have items for your family to remain safe and taken care of for at least three days. Pack the contents of your kit in something you can carry with ease and store it somewhere dry and easy to access. Include in your kit:

- Two litres of water per person per day
- Non-perishable food and manual can opener
- Wind-up or battery powered flashlight and radio
- First aid kit
- Cash and extra keys
- Important family documents such as identification, insurance and bank records
- A copy of your emergency plan



Also consider including items related to your household's unique needs, such as prescription medication, medical equipment, pet food and infant formula.

Know Your Watering Days

Summer is a great time to enjoy our yards and gardens, but it's also when water use is at its highest. By conserving water and following seasonal watering restrictions, we can all do our part to protect our shared water supply. Use water wisely and keep our community healthy and thriving all summer long!

Restrictions

- Effective June 1 – September 15 every year.
- Residents with odd number civic addresses may use outdoor water on odd number calendar days.
- Residents with even number civic addresses may use outdoor water on even number calendar days.
- Residents may only water lawns and gardens between the hours of 12 a.m. to 8 a.m. or 7 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. on their scheduled days.

The Township of Springwater will be hosting an Open House to present proposed updates to the Recreation, Parks and Facilities fees and charges, as well as the methodology used to establish the proposed rates.

Open House - Hunter Russell Trail

The Township of Springwater will be hosting an Open House for the Hunter Russell Trail bridge and trail replacement project.

The north entrance to the Hunter Russell Trail, including Pedestrian Bridge P1, has been damaged by erosion, stormwater, and unstable ground in the area. Technical review completed for the Township determined that the best long-term solution is to replace the current bridge and rebuild the northern section of the trail. This would include a new prefabricated pedestrian bridge and a raised boardwalk in the areas most affected by erosion.

The open house will provide an opportunity for community members to learn more about the project, review the proposed design, and ask questions of Township staff and consultants.
