Spring Watermain Flushing

The Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) will be flushing watermain for the Township throughout April and May. It is very important to **REDUCE** water use from **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** on the dates listed below so that **OCWA** can effectively complete the maintenance.

April 20 - April 24	Elmvale & Hillsdale
April 27 - May 1	Anten Mills, Phelpston & Del Trend
May 4 - May 8	Midhurst & Minesing
May 11 - May 15	Snow Valley Highlands, Snow Valley Lowlands, Centre Vespra (including Stonemanor Woods)
May 14 SWABBING	Vespra Downs

*For areas being swabbed, we ask that residents **STOP** using water during these hours.


During or after this flushing period, you may experience discoloured water and/or low water pressure. If this happens, we suggest that you try the following: Remove the tap aerators off your taps and flush all the house lines until the water runs clear. If necessary, flush out your hot water tanks.

Protect Your Pipes This Season

Baby wipes, dental floss, salad dressing and bacon grease. What do they all have in common? These items can block your pipes if you put them down the sink or toilet. Blocked pipes are big trouble as they can burst or back up, leading to costly flooding in your home or business. Further down the line, items like wipes and grease can clog sewers and cause toxic sewage overflows into streets and the natural environment. They can also damage local wastewater infrastructure. Remember, just because something says it's flushable, doesn't mean it is.

Did you know that some cooking oils don't harden, but they can still stick to pipes? Small amounts can be absorbed in the green bin. After cooking, allow fats, oils and grease to cool and harden in pans or pour liquid into a heat-safe container such as a tin can to cool and harden the cooking liquid. Then scrape hardened fats, oils and grease into the green bin.



- The Township works in partnership with DocuPet to provide pet licensing. This ensures lost pets get home safely.
- Every dog in Springwater must be licensed.
- Pets must wear the licensing tag on their collar at all times.
- There is a limit of four dogs per single detached home or two dogs per multi-residential household.
- Licenses last for 365 days from the date of purchase.
