

Mayoral Decision**MD-2025-008****A decision to veto a resolution making an amendment to the proposed
2026/27 Budget and shorten the veto period**

In accordance with Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Subsections 284.16(4) power to veto a resolution passed under Subsection 284.16(3);

The Mayor hereby directs the following;

1. That the Mayor's veto power under Subsection 284.16(4) of the Municipal Act, 2001 be used to veto the following budget amendment that was passed by Council at its Regular Meeting on December 3, 2025;
 - a. Resolution C505-2025: That the paving of Idlewood from Frid Blvd to Neretva be included in the 2026 capital budget, at an estimated cost of \$100,000.00, to be funded from the Tax Rate Stabilization Fund.
2. That, in the opinion of the Mayor the amendment be vetoed for the following reasons;
 - a. The amendment depletes the Townships ability to sustainably invest in new infrastructure to support growth. In addition, the rehabilitation of this portion of road is not identified in the 10-year capital plan as the pavement is deemed in fair condition.
3. That this Mayoral Decision provides written notice under Subsection 7(7) of O. Reg. 530/22 to shorten the 10-day period to veto a budget amendment resolution passed by Council to the proposed budget, to the date of this Mayoral Decision.

This mayoral decision shall come into effect this 8th day of December, 2025.
